

Exhibit Hall Map Description & List by Table Number

EXHIBIT HALL OVERVIEW:

The exhibit hall space is located in Griffin Hall on the second level of the JW Marriott Austin. The space is a rectangle--the entrance is on the wider side and the left and right sides are shorter.

Exhibitor tables are located along the entire perimeter of the room (placing the exhibitors' backs to the walls) and in the middle of the room in blocks that you can walk around. The tables along the perimeter walls are Row A. There are five large rectangles of tables in the center of the room with aisles in between. These are Block B, Block C, Block D, Block E, and Block F. When you enter through the main doorway to Griffin Hall, you will be facing the aisle between Block B and Block C, the NFB information table is directly to your right, and the state affiliate and national division tables are in Block F towards the far-right side of the room.

Each exhibitor table has large-print and Braille numbers and a table name that identify the exhibitor. Table numbers can be found on the front corners of each table, and the table names are in the middle. The exhibiting sponsor tables are located toward the front of the hall.

The Independence Market and Federation Free Reads are one level above the exhibit hall in Salon D of the Lone Star Ballroom this year.
